THEME ENTRY FEES

'The tool/s one cannot live without'. No entry fee is required.

LINE LIMITS PRIZE (subject to Judge's discretion):

Maximum 50 Shire of Mundaring Prize: \$300

Conditions of Entry

- DEADLINE: 5.00pm AWST Friday 5 October 2018.
- You must be aged 18 years or over to enter this competition.
- Work to be original, unpublished (anything that has appeared in the public arena, including self-publishing and social media, is considered published) either in print or online, not have received an award in another competition, and not under consideration elsewhere from the time of entry in these awards until the official announcement of winners.
- Open style, open theme, traditional or contemporary.
- Limit of three poems per author.
- Entries to be typed, printed, 1.5 or single-spaced on one side only of A4 white paper, with pages numbered, and entry title on each page. Post to Boya Library, 119-135 Scott Street, Helena Valley, 6056, in an A4-sized envelope (C4).
- To ensure anonymity NO WRITERS' NAMES TO APPEAR ON MANUSCRIPTS (MS). Please attach a COVER SHEET with title of poem and line count.
- MS will not be returned and will be destroyed after the competition, so keep a copy of your work.
- Results and judges' reports will be posted on the Shire of Mundaring website on Wednesday 17 October.
- The winner will be notified by email prior to the public announcement on Wednesday 17 October.
- Employees and family members of employees of the Shire of Mundaring and the KSP Competitions Secretary and the KSP Board of Management are ineligible to enter.
- Award placements are issued only by discretion of the judge in the event of a worthy winning entry. The judges' decisions are final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The Shire of Mundaring and the KSP Foundation Inc. reserve the right to publish the winning entry or entries online or in a publication related to KSP and the Shire of Mundaring should the opportunity occur, in consultation with the author.
- If entering multiple times, you must complete a separate entry form and cover sheet for each poem. You can mail all entries and forms together in one envelope.
- Final checklist: Ensure your submission/s includes a completed and signed entry form with clearly legible details (loose), plus entry and completed cover sheet (stapled).
- Entries which do not reflect the stated conditions, which are not accompanied by a fully filled Entry Form or are postmarked later than the deadline may be disqualified.
